If no transportation is available, the school will deliver the packet to the child’s home. -School staff fed 678 students today.
Government Offices Closed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Perquimans County offices are encouraging their customers to conduct business with the County either electronically or by telephone if possible. -Effective March 23, 2020 the Town of Hertford is suspending face-to-face customer service. All business will be handled via email, online or phone until further notice. -Regional Library Closed March 16, 2020 for 2 weeks -Senior Center is closed through March 31, 2020 -Recreation Department is closed through March 31, 2020 -Extension Office cancelled programs through March 31, 2020 -Effective March 20, 2020, the County Water Department has closed the lobby. The drive thru will still be accessible to customers. -Effective March 20, 2020 at 12 p.m., Department of Social Services has closed its public lobby until further notice. All business will be handled by phone or electronically and there is a Drop Off Box in the foyer of the building for paperwork. -Effective March 20, 2020, the Sheriff’s Office will no longer be fingerprinting but will continue to offer concealed carry permit renewals and handgun purchase permits. -Register of Deed’s Office will be accepting clients by appointments only
